



RADIO TELEGRAPHY CLUB

General information

The Radio Telegraphy Club was founded on March 10th, 1990 by eighteen amateur radio operators of the former GDR (East Germany). The goals of the club are to preserve, foster and encourage the use of Morse Code in ham radio. Main emphasis is put on the personal ability of the operator to transmit and receive CW without technical aids such as computers, keyboards or decoders!

Any ham radio operator or short wave listener who meets with the prerequisites for membership and is in agreement with the goals of RTC, is welcome to join.

Minimum score of 500 points for contacts and awards.

Each 2-way CW QSO counts for 1 point on short wave bands, 2 points on VHF/UHF.

Only those contacts within 12 months prior to the date of application can be considered.

Contest QSOs do not count!

Each basic award for 2-way CW counts 50 points with a total of five awards creditable.

Membership awards (f.e. HSC, AGCW, FOC, BTC etc.) do not count!

Each 2-way CW QSO of at least 60 minutes duration (speed being no factor) counts 50 points. These QSOs must be documented by QSL cards showing beginning and ending time. Sent as copy in jpg-formate.

Sent your application per email only. Please use ADIF, EXCEL or TXT formate. You will receive your membership documents at the same way back.

There is no fee.
